

## Year 10 Subject: Citizenship

You need to be spending **3 hours** per week on this subject.

### Activity to complete:

#### What is the most effective way to deal with crime and criminals?

- I can describe how crime can be prevented.
- I can explain alternative solutions to prison.
- I can evaluate how effective prison is as a solution to crime.

Learners are recapping their previous learning focusing on the causes of crime by exploring ways to prevent crime and how to deal effectively with perpetrators of crime. This will culminate in an exam question based on this topic.

### Work to be submitted to your teacher:

Learners will submit an exam question answer to their teacher via email. The essay question is below:

#### **Oppose the view that prison is the best place for criminals [8 marks]**

To answer this question learners need to write at least three paragraphs giving three separate alternatives to prison and why they are a better way of dealing with criminals than prison and/or explaining the disadvantages of sending criminals to prison. They could add another paragraph giving the other side of the argument and explaining why sometimes prison is the best solution.
