Dear Families,

RE: Holidays abroad and quarantine expectations

I hope you are enjoying the summer break and the variable British weather!

We are aware some families may have taken the opportunity to travel abroad during the summer holidays and we hope that very few of you will have been impacted by the need to quarantine on return, as per the ever-changing government advice on international travel. You can find the government guidance on foreign travel by clicking [here](#).

As we prepare for learners to return to school in September, it is important that if any families have been, or are currently, abroad and are required to quarantine for 14 days on their return to the United Kingdom that families stringently follow this advice. **Learners should not return to school in September if they are in quarantine following international travel.** They should only return to school once the 14 day quarantine period is over.

I would be grateful that if your child is required to quarantine at the start of the academic year that you contact me via email or at school to notify me. We will endeavour to provide work for your child to complete whilst they are quarantining at home. The government is yet to provide guidance on how schools should mark their registers in relation to coronavirus and quarantining, but until this is clarified learners who are quarantining will be marked as a C – other authorised circumstances.

Overleaf is a list of countries where quarantine **is not** required on return to the United Kingdom. If your family has travelled to a country not on this list, you will be required to quarantine. Please note that this list changes regularly and is only right as of 18th August. There is currently much speculation that Greece, Turkey and Croatia are likely to be added, before September, to the list of countries where quarantine is required.

Notably, if your family has travelled to Spain, Portugal, France, Malta, the Netherlands, or Belgium (amongst other countries), then you are required to quarantine for 14 days on your return to the UK.

As a school we cannot support families taking leaves of absence for family holidays during term time unless in exceptional circumstances (at the discretion of the Head Teacher). Given that learners have not been in school since March, it is more important than ever that learners do not take holidays in term time. Furthermore, when taking the decision to take a holiday, families should be aware of the potential need to quarantine on return and how this guidance changes very regularly and at short notice. Any time unnecessarily missed from school is damaging to a
