

Year 10 Subject: History

You need to be spending **3 hours** per week on this subject.

Activity to complete:

What illnesses would a soldier suffer from?

- I can identify at least two illnesses soldiers suffered from during the First World War
- I can explain how these diseases were linked to the environment soldiers were living in.
- I can give examples of how the responses to these illnesses changed over time.

Learners will continue their study of Medicine through time and focus specifically on illnesses caused by trench warfare in WW1 and they will practise their source based exam skills

Work to be submitted to your teacher:

In their first hour of remote learning, learners will investigate the four illnesses caused by trench warfare and complete a table which details the causes, impacts and treatments of these illnesses.

In their second hour of remote learning, learners will build on the information and skills taught in their live lesson to answer two exam questions.

All remote learning tasks will be emailed to learners before their scheduled lesson.
